

# Waterfall Trail



This 131-acre privately-owned property in was permanently protected in 2010 with a Conservation Restriction jointly held by Hilltown Land Trust and the MA Department of Conservation and Recreation.

This land was conserved to protect water resources and wildlife habitat and allow for continued use of some of the land for farming. There are two streams on the property, Porter Brook and Tower Brook, that flow from wetlands.

The property includes a public trail that extends approximately half a mile from Porter Hill Road to an attractive waterfall on Tower Brook. The land remains in private ownership, but the landowners allow the public to hike the trail. Please respect the property and stay on the trails.

This property is an active farm, there may be some sugaring lines across the trail during maple sugaring season and please keep all dogs on leash to avoid interference with farm animals.

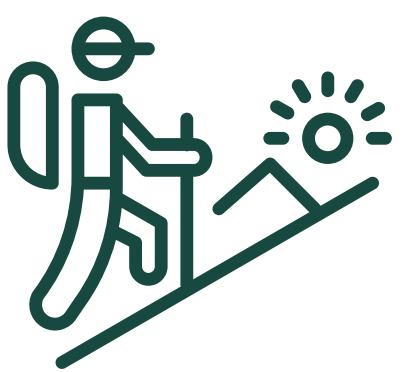
## PROPERTY GUIDELINES

Respect the land & nearby neighbors

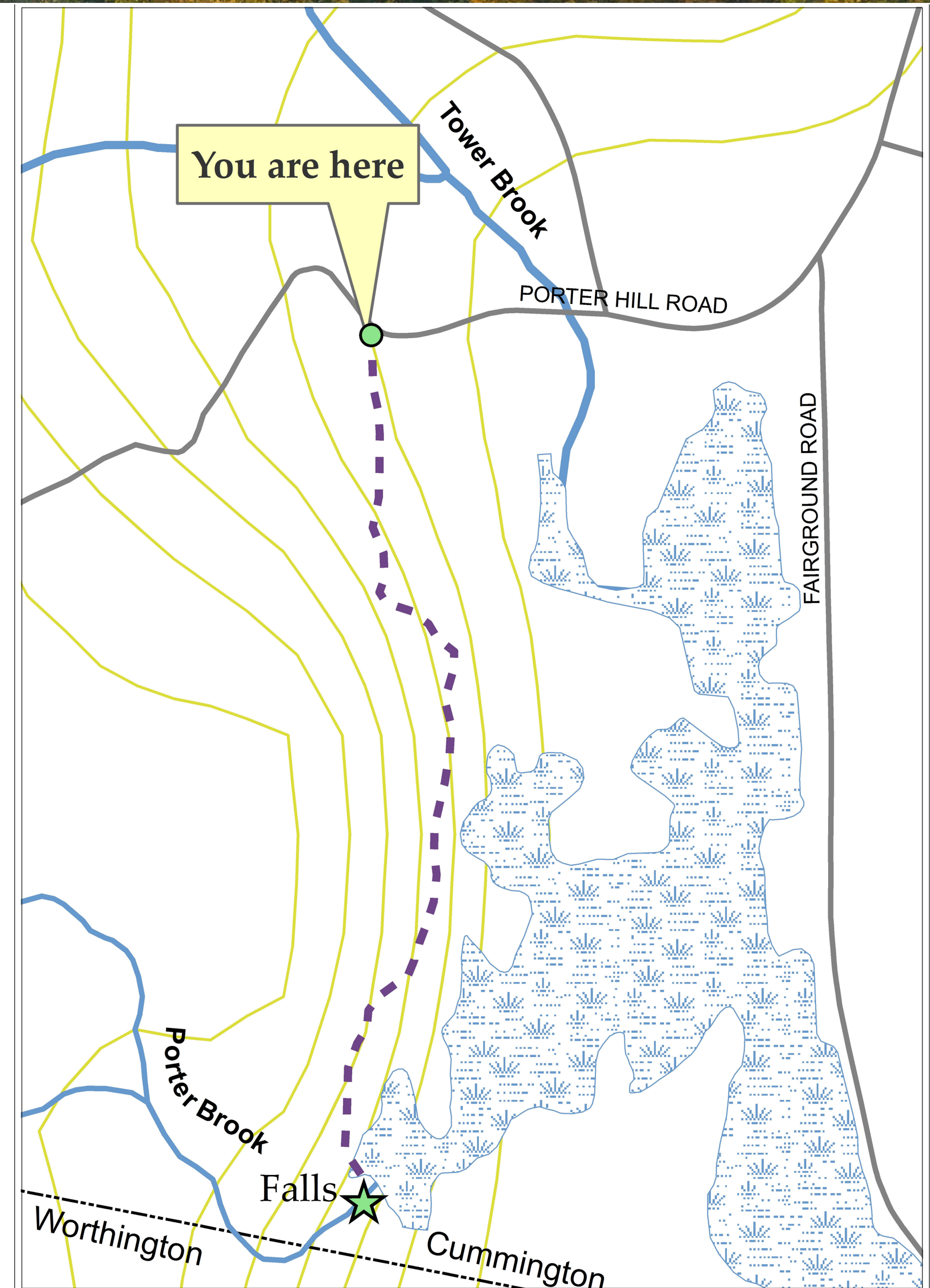


No ATVs
